



How to get there

- 1. Go to: http://intelliconnect.cch.com
- Open Practice Areas and confirm that Litigation is available and selected. Click Apply and OK to save changes, if needed.
- 3. Click **Browse** on the **Quick Bar**. Locate and click on the Litigation Library to expand the menu.
