## Rounding of Dollar Amounts in IntelliForms ${ }^{\text {TM }}$

As a development standard, IntelliForms rounds dollar amounts to the whole dollar on most forms (i.e., cents are not shown). This cannot be changed by a user.


The rounding standard is based on IRS guidelines as indicated in Section 5.2.7 of IRS Publication 1167, General Rules and Specifications for Substitute Forms and Schedules. For state and local forms, IntelliForms defaults to this federal rounding standard unless a tax agency specifically indicates that cents must be displayed.


Exceptions to this standard generally exist for sales \& use tax forms and payroll forms (where IntelliForms allows cents to be input).
