USDA Makes CARES Act-Funded ReConnect Award for North Carolina

The U.S. Department of Agriculture has awarded Randolph Telephone Membership Corp. \$2.3 million in ReConnect Pilot Program grant funding authorized by the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act earlier this year (TR Daily, March 31). Randolph Telephone will use the funding to deploy a fiber-to-the-premises (FTTP) network in North Carolina's Moore County. The ReConnect program was originally authorized with \$600 million in funding by omnibus appropriations legislation in 2018 (TR Daily, March 23, 2018).
